FCF Campsite Teaching Activities and Frontier Village

Our wonderful FCF men will be with us again this year with a full menu of exciting activities! Through their expertise and dedication to Girls Statewide Campout, our girls are provided unique and fun experiences they virtually will not experience anywhere else. The girls will learn and perform skills that build confidence and a sense of accomplishment through activities.

FCF Saturday morning Campsite Teaching

- Dutch oven cooking (**each campsite should bring**):
 - a Dutch oven,
 - a Duncan Hines Yellow cake mix, 2 -29 oz. cans of sliced peaches, apple, cherry, blueberry etc,
 - 3 eggs
 - Oil as instructed on the cake mix box
 - One can of 7up or Sprite
- ropes and knots
- lashing (tying things together),
- Fire building and the handling knives and hand axes.

FCF/ Frontier Village Saturday Afternoon activities will include:

- Archery
- Black powder shooting
- Canoeing & water bikes
- Rope bridge
- Beading,
- Black smiting,
- Hawk throwing
- Apple Fritters and Cider Pressing:
 - each campsite should bring a minimum of 2 apples per person attending camp from your group

Because the FCF and the Minutemen will be up all night keeping an eye on our safety and assisting in anything that needs to be done in the campsites, we also request that your group bring 1 dozen homemade treats for them as they serve us.

What to Bring for your Campsite

If you have never been to Girls Campout before - you need to know that Lake Placid Bible Camp is a Rustic campground. There is no electricity, running water, or bathrooms available. There are "biffies" which the girls will become very fond of ☺. Trust us...every bit of sacrifice for a real camping experience for the girls is worth it. The girls LOVE the camping experience. There will be plenty of minute men and assistance around to help with anything you may need so don't hold back if you are an inexperienced camper.

Your group will need to bring EVERYTHING you need to have campfires, make meals over the fire, clean up, cooking utensils, safety equipment, tents, sleeping bags etc. on the web site you will find a suggested list of things you will need. There are also experienced churches that would be willing to share a campsite with you during your first year at camp so you don't miss out on the great camping experience.
