2. The applicant will not be eligible for membership until he has successfully completed each Phase testing.
3. After the Phase 1 test, the applicant will be notified via mail whether he has passed. If successful, he should be prepared to pay the admission fee at the test site for Phase 2 testing, held on or about the first weekend in May.
4. Phase 3 testing will be held at the annual Statewide Campout on or about the first weekend in June.
