Dear Leader,

The Minnesota Chapter of the FCF has adopted a new way of assessing the proficiency of the skills needed to qualify for admission. *Each boy and leader will be required to attend an SAR (Skills Achievement Review) prior to the Big Adventure.* This review will replace the attendance in JFC for all boys. Leaders will still need to complete their LTA and attend a national training event.

The SAR will take place in three different places within the state. These locations split the state up to make travel less expensive for the applicants. There is also no cost to attend this event.

The purpose is not to test the applicants, and no scores will be tallied. This merely helps us prepare each one to do well at the Big Adventure and also enjoy the experience.

The review consists of all the major areas contained in the Trail of the Grizzly. Each applicant will be asked to demonstrate various skills and recite important information about the Ranger program. Once the stations have been completed, one copy of the review will be given to the sponsoring commander (the one signing off the merits) for boys, or directly to commanders attending the review. A second copy will be given to the FCF president for his records.

From the time of the review, each applicant can use the result of their review to improve any areas that need attention. The Big Adventure remains the same.

The dates and locations for this review will be included in the application.
