

## MN KIDS CAMP JOB DESCRIPTION – REC TEAM MEMBER

### OBJECTIVE

Assist and coordinate campers in various activities and games.

### REPORT TO

Rec. Coordinator

### RESPONSIBILITIES

#### Pre-camp

1. Pray for all campers, volunteers and Evangelists.
2. Read and understand Camp Volunteer Manual.

#### Camp

1. Help set up Rec. activities around camp the day before Day 1 of camp.
  - Be available to set up and tear down different activities throughout the session as needed.
2. Supervise and lead assigned Rec. activity during Rec. Periods.
  - Do not leave your assigned area until your task is complete.
  - If you finish your duties early, immediately report to the Rec. Coordinator.
3. Support the camp leadership with Halftime and Game On, as needed.
4. Clean up and make sure your assigned area is ready for the next day's activities during Evening Service.
  - Once your area is ready for the next day, attend the Service, sitting with the campers, participating and being an example in the service.
5. Verify your assigned area is ready for the first Rec. period during Morning Service.
  - Once your area is ready for the day, attend the service, sitting with the campers, participating and being an example in the service.
6. Meal Server.
  - Arrive at the time listed on the schedule for the meals you are assigned by the Rec Coordinator.
  - You will eat before serving.
7. Other various duties maybe required, as needed.

### PERSONAL EXPECTATIONS

1. BE EXCITED and have a good attitude! Camp is for the campers! Enjoy where you're stationed and have fun with it!
2. Respect and listen to LGCC Staff, Camp Leadership, and District Staff.
3. Follow all curfews as explained in the Camp Volunteer Manual.
4. Dress appropriately. I.E. No low cut shirts, mid-drifts, short shorts, bikinis. Wear a shirt at all times, comfortable clothes, etc.
5. Be available to help with anything.
6. No guys in girl's rooms and no girls in guy's rooms. NO EXCEPTIONS.
