

OBJECTIVE

Support Senior Leadership by being an encourager and main point of contact to Color Team and Counselors.

REQUIREMENTS

1. Spirit-filled with the evidence of speaking in tongues.
2. Prayer life consists of regularly praying in prayer language (tongues).
3. Competent to have Spiritual dialog and discussion on these areas: Salvation, Baptism in the Holy Spirit, Gifts of the Holy Spirit, Healing.
4. Physically able to encourage Color Team by jumping, shouting and running with enthusiasm.

RESPONSIBILITIES

Pre-camp

1. Pray for all campers, volunteers and Evangelists.
2. Attend pre-camp Color Team Pastor video meeting by zoom.us
3. Read and understand the Camp Volunteer Manual.

Camp

1. Be present at Camper & Counselor Orientations on the afternoon of Day 1
 - Report to the Worship Center 10 minutes before the beginning of the Camper Orientation. Coordinator and Camp MC will introduce you to the campers.
 - Go to the Event Center to lead the Color Team portion of the Counselor Orientation. The Assistant Coordinators will have notes so you know what you need to cover in your meeting.
2. Large Group
 - Morning Service – Participate in Game On before service. Provide pastoral care and oversight during service. Help with small group discussions or prayer stations as needed. Be at the front of the stage during altar calls to pray with kids, you will get more direction from the Camp Speaker for each service.
 - Evening Service – Participate in Game On before service. Provide pastoral care and oversight during service. Help with small group discussions or prayer stations as needed. Be at the front of the stage during altar calls to pray with kids.
 - Halftime – Crowd control and participate in games
 - ✓ Please arrive at least 10 minutes before the beginning of Halftime so that you are ready when counselors bring their kids to the Worship Center.
 - ✓ You will be participating in messy activities during this session. Please wear a shirt that can get messy under your Ref shirt so

that you can take the Ref shirt off to keep it clean for the rest of the session.

3. Communication

- **Meet with Camp Coordinator when Coordinator requests.**
- **Communicate announcements and reminders to all counselors in your Color Team.**
- **Counselors report to Color Team Pastors**
- **Discipline: Report all disciplinary issues to Assistant Coordinator or Coordinator.**

4. Recreation Periods

- **Rec Periods – Be visible and present at all Rec Periods. Cheer your team on and build relationships with counselors and kids.**

5. Misc.

- **Be flexible and willing to help wherever an Assistant Coordinator asks you.**

6. Meal Server

- **Arrive at the time listed on the schedule for the meals you are assigned.**
- **You will eat before serving.**
