The Prime Timers ministry at the Waters Church in Sartell began in April 2021. Pastor Doug Vagle met with us to consider this ministry as he saw a need to reach the 60+ and the retired. He asked us to be part-time staff and launch this ministry. We started with a short list of seniors and formed an Action Team to help us plan. A luncheon is held the 2nd Thursday of each month and seniors are encouraged to invite friends. Chicken is catered by Pizza Ranch and those who attend bring sides, salads, or desserts. This event includes music from staff, a devotional, "My story" testimonies from the seniors, and guest speakers. Some have shared their talents such as photography. A wellness coordinator from the church has spoken on Alzheimer's and dementia. In November, 78 seniors and staff attended a catered Thanksgiving

luncheon served by the pastoral staff. It was a blessing to meet new seniors and enjoy the fellowship! The youth/children's pastors were asked to share their need for volunteers and several from the group are serving joyfully in these areas.
