Dr. Allen Tennison serves as a professor of Theology at NCU. He also serves as Dean of the College of Church Leadership, and is a member of the Society for Pentecostal Studies and the American Academy of Religion. He has authored articles on Pentecostalism and pneumatology, and will soon be releasing his new book, *Logic of the Spirit*. His wife, Rhonda, who will be joining us this weekend, is an AG missionary to children at risk in both Los Angeles and the Twin Cities area.



Martha Tennison worked as a telephone operator when she married W. Don Tennison, then a preacher serving a church in Texas. Martha credits him with putting her into the pulpit. She recalls that she often approached her husband with sermon ideas, and one day he said, "Well, Sunday night, you're up." Martha protested that she was not a preacher, but Don replied, "God gave you a message, and you are to deliver that message."



On a May day in 1988, while the Tennisons were pastoring in Radcliff KY, 66 youth, youth workers and one driver boarded the church bus, headed for a theme park. As they were returning home, they were struck nearly head-on by a drunk driver in a pickup truck. The incident resulted in the deaths of three pastoral staff members and 24 children (their only son, Allen, was on the bus, but was not injured.) This incident impacted not only the church and the Radcliff community—but has had an ongoing effect throughout the United States.

Known for her powerful preaching as well as her lively and humorous delivery, this octogenarian continues to have many opportunities to preach in churches and at events. She is a bi-annual favorite of the students at NCU, who lovingly refer to her as "Mother Tennison."

We are so pleased to have Allen, Rhonda and Martha with us for this year's retreat—make sure you don't miss a single minute!

For the past 18 years, **The Kingery Family**, from central Minnesota, have been singing and ministering together. They began as a family of ten - Mike, Chris, and their eight children - but have grown to include three sons-in-law and nine grandchildren!

Their music includes gospel bluegrass, a little fiddle, a touch of patriotic, a taste of Americana, and some acapella.
