The Prime Timers Seniors at The Waters church in Sartell helped launch the Intentional Grandparenting life group in 2022. Marie Schutz is the leader of this group which meets once a month on a Saturday morning. The group includes amazing young and older grandparents. Marie and a young grandparent, Brian Majaski, had a vision of planning an event for area grandparents with Dr. Josh Mulvihill as the speaker. Dr. Mulvihill is the Director of Church and Family Ministry at "Renew A Nation" and is the author or editor of ten books on grandparenting. Brian and Marie reached out to a local Grandparenting Collaborative and to other churches who came alongside them to help with the event

on October 4, 2024. "The Remnant" as the event was called, refers to Romans 11:5 (NIV) which speaks of the 7000 faithful who would not bow a knee to Baal (the worldview of that day.) The topics addressed by Dr. Mulvihill were "Understanding the Biblical Role of Grandparents," and "Why Every Child and Grandchild Needs a Biblical World View". We are so grateful to Brian and Marie as well as the more than 25 volunteers from 8 area churches who made this event happen! It is the hope of the planners to promote future events which encourage both Christian parents and grandparents to share their faith and legacy to future generations. May we allow the Holy Spirit to move in our lives and empower us to bring our children and grandchildren to a Biblical Worldview as well as a much deeper faith in Christ


2024 2nd Half Ministries Legacy Scholarship Project
