We are Introducing our QR code to you - QR Codes are becoming more popular these days. What are they, and how do you use them, you say? Glad you asked! Pictured here is the 2nd Half Ministries QR Code. By using it you will be taken directly to our ministry webpage. Jim Olson, a member of our leadership team, explains its use for us........

Imagine a QR code like a special kind of barcode, similar to those you might see on groceries, but with more information packed into it. Here's how it works:

- 1. **What It Looks Like**: A QR code is a small square with lots of black and white patterns. It might look a bit like a modern art piece, but each part of it has a specific purpose.
- 2. **How It Works**: When you use your smartphone camera to look at the QR code, the camera reads the pattern and understands the information inside it. This might be a website link, a phone number, or some other piece of information.
- 3. **Using It**: To use a QR code, you simply use your camera (many phones can scan QR codes directly through their camera app). Point the camera at the QR code, and your phone will usually show you a message or take you to a webpage with more information. In short, QR codes are like a digital shortcut that can instantly provide you with information or link you to a website just by scanning with your phone.
