PURPOSE OF THIS CAMP

Frontiersmen Camping Fellowship (FCF) is a special program of Royal Rangers that provides men and boys with additional opportunities to develop specialized outdoor skills based on the lore and traditions of the early American frontiersmen. FCF members participate in special events where frontier skills are demonstrated and practiced.

WHO CAN ATTEND?

The following requirements must be met to become a member of FCF and attain "Frontiersman" status.

Requirements for BOYS

1. Be at least 11 years old and a graduate of the 5th grade
2. Complete a Frontier Adventure event. (This is that camp!)
3. Be an active member of a chartered Royal Rangers outpost, and be recommended for membership by your Pastor and Outpost Coordinator
4. Complete all requirements for the following skill merits: Camping and First Aid Skills (or First Aid/CPR).

Requirements for LEADERS

1. Be at least 18 years old.
2. Complete a Frontier Adventure event. (This is that camp!)
3. Be an active member of a chartered Royal Rangers outpost, and be recommended for membership by your Pastor and Outpost Coordinator
4. Be in good standing in your church, regularly practicing a Christlike lifestyle.
5. Earn the READY and SAFETY levels of the Outpost Leader Advancement Levels of training.

MEDICAL EXAMINATION

Your son, or you, must be in good health to participate in the strenuous activities of the training camp. Therefore, it is required that he has a physical examination. After the examination, please sign the following statement, "after consultation with child's physician, I know of no physical reason that would restrict my son, or myself, from participating in camp activities" on the camp application.

In addition, please fill out the Minnesota District Royal Ranger Activity Emergency Medical Information and Authorization Form and bring to the camp with you.

REGISTRATION FEE

A \$25 non-refundable fee must accompany the application. The registration cost is \$150 if received by June 30th, and \$200 on or after July 1st. If for any reason you are unable to attend the camp, you must notify Mike Severson, Junior Training Camp Coordinator, TWO WEEKS prior to the camp to receive a refund. 1. **\$50.00 discount if register by June 30th.**
2. **\$20.00 discount for 2 camps/family discount. (same person or siblings)**
