PURPOSE OF THIS CAMP

Boys and men will receive specialized training in how to handle canoes safely in many scenarios and learn techniques in water rescue and survival while on a two-day trip in some of the most beautiful canoe country in Minnesota.



WHO CAN ATTEND?

Royal Rangers who have written permission from their parents and:

- 1. Completed grade 6
- 2. Boys must have successfully completed Junior Training Camp.
- 3. Men are also eligible to attend
- 4. Have earned their Swimming Merit and have good basic swimming skills

MEDICAL EXAMINATION

Your son must be in good health to participate in the strenuous activities of the training camp. Therefore, it is required that he has a physical examination. After the examination, please sign the following statement, "after consultation with child's physician, I know of no physical reason that would restrict my son from participating in camp activities" on the camp application.

In addition, please fill out the Minnesota District Royal Ranger Activity Emergency Medical Information and Authorization Form and bring to the camp with you.

REGISTRATION FEE

A \$25 non-refundable fee must accompany the application. The registration cost is \$150 if received by June 30th, and \$200 on or after July 1st. If for any reason you are unable to attend the camp, you must notify Mike Severson, Junior Training Camp Coordinator, TWO WEEKS prior to the camp to receive a refund. - 1. \$50.00 discount if register by June 30th.
- 2. \$20.00 discount for 2 camps/family discount. (same person or siblings)
