WELCOME TO FAMILY CAMP!

We are so happy to have you at LGCC Family Camp. It is our privilege to serve you. We hope your stay is pleasant and memorable for all involved. For the comfort and safety of all guests, we have several policies and guidelines in place. Anyone failing to abide by these may be asked to leave the grounds.

- **Check-in time is 3:00 p.m. Check-out time is 11:00 a.m.** Thank you for following these times, as we have other guests arriving & using LGCC before & after Family Camp.
- **Bicycles, skateboards, and scooters are not allowed in or near any buildings.** This includes the Worship Center. No one under the age of 16 may drive anything motorized on the grounds. This includes golf carts, scooters, bikes, skateboards, etc.
 - Young children on bicycles can be hazardous. Please keep them off walkways & use extreme caution on roadways.
- **No cooking is allowed in any housing units.** Additionally, Alexandria's fire code does not allow food grilling on wood decks. Grilling must be done 10' from any building.
- **No pets** (except for SERVICE ANIMALS defined by Title II & Title III of the ADA) are allowed in LGCC buildings or on the grounds. Small pets are permitted in the Hillcrest RV Park ONLY in personally owned RVs. Owners must clean up after their pets & keep them on a leash at all times. Pets must be confined inside the RV when owners are not present.
- **NO ALCOHOL, TOBACCO, VAPING, ILLEGAL DRUGS, WEAPONS, or FIREWORKS** are allowed on the grounds.
- Please respect our neighbors and avoid blocking their driveways or trespassing on their property.
- Persons who damage or remove camp property will be charged accordingly. No A/C in primitive cabins! This poses a fire danger and blows fuses.
- **INSURANCE:** Secondary insurance coverage is carried by LGCC. All injuries must first be submitted to the individual camper's insurance holder. Please report all injuries to the nurse or the Welcome Center Office.

- **PLEASE DRIVE VERY SLOWLY; the speed limit is 9 mph** on the grounds. Only drive when necessary. Parking is available on the west side of the Dining Hall, the ball field, and north of the Retreat Center. **FIRELANES** must remain clear at all times and vehicles blocking will be towed.
- In respect of all guests and our surrounding community, the 11:00 p.m. City of Alexandria noise curfew will be strictly enforced. Night Watch will be on duty each night.
- Shirts and shoes must be worn at all times, including the Dining Hall. (Beachfront & Land Blob are the exceptions)

You will find Family Camp is a great opportunity to:

- Draw near to the Lord and grow in your relationship with Him.
- Spend quality time as a family.
- Reconnect with friends & enjoy fellowship.
- Relax and unwind from the “normal” pace and routine of life.

PARENTS: Please keep in mind that during Family Camp, there are NO counselors/supervision provided. Children under 18 must always be under adult supervision. YOU are responsible for the safety and supervision of your children.

Children may not be in the pool or beachfront areas without an adult!

LGCC AQUATIC CENTER & BEACHFRONT POLICIES

DAILY 1-5 PM (NOT OPEN JUNE 26 OR JULY 5)

- All children under the age of 16 must always have an adult with them when they are in the pool, hot tub, or at the beachfront.
 - Infants & untrained toddlers must wear swim diapers.
 - As per CDC & State of Minnesota guidelines, NO small children or infants may use the hot tub.
- A limit of 95 Guests is allowed in the Aquatic Center at one time.
- Please limit yourself to 1 hour so others can use the facilities.
- **Guests must acquaint themselves with all posted Aquatic Center signs.**
- **NO LIFEGUARDS are present in the Aquatic Center**
- **Beachfront water toys are not to be used when lifeguards are not present.**
- **All guests using the pool or hot tub must shower before entering the water.**
- **To use the waterslide, read the guidelines first. NO WATERSLIDE USE when an attendant is not present, and the gate is locked. Do not climb on the slide or over the gate.**
- **Modest swimwear is required for all guests anywhere on the campgrounds.**
- **No glitter or body paint permitted.**
- **No swimsuits with zippers or “bling” permitted on slide!**
- **NO FOOD or BEVERAGE permitted in the Aquatic Center or hot tub, except for water in a plastic or metal bottle.**
- **NO GLASS bottles or containers in the Aquatic Center!**
- **Do not use the pool or hot tub alone at any time.**
- **No running in the pool area.**
- **No fishing on or near the beach area.**

The Aquatic Center is equipped with security cameras and alarms. Unauthorized entry outside open hours will result in immediate dismissal from the grounds.

GENERAL TORNADO SAFETY

You are in DOUGLAS COUNTY at Lake Geneva Christian Center. Sirens will sound in the event of a Tornado Warning. Take shelter immediately.

- Be alert to changing weather conditions. You may wish to have a battery-operated transistor radio to use during adverse weather.
- A "tornado watch" means that the necessary conditions for a tornado are present.
- A "tornado warning" means that a tornado has been sighted. Take shelter immediately. The Alexandria city sirens will indicate that you need to take shelter immediately.
- Locate the closest shelter. The ideal shelter is a basement with a reinforced location for protection from falling objects. This may be under a stairwell, a sturdy table, or a workbench. If you are not near a basement, select an interior closet or small room with no windows. Never stay in a mobile home or camper.
- If you cannot get to one of the listed storm shelters, seek shelter in an interior room away from any windows.
- Stay in the shelter until the all-clear is given.
- Remain calm and assist those needing assurance.
